Purpose:	The purpose of this policy is to provide definitions of membership to the AAFIE Foundation (AAFIE) in order to ensure good governance standards expected under the Australian Charities and Non-for-profit Commission (ACNC) are met by providing clear accountability to members.
Policy Statement:	That membership of the AAFIE are open to all educators, researchers, and policy makers who are aligned to AAFIE's fundamental belief – that all young people, regardless of postcode, have equal access to inclusive, positive future focused educational opportunities, specific to their needs.
Membership:	The Constitution of the AAFIE Foundation outlines the governance around membership of the organisation, including the classes of members of the Company and the rights of the members such as voting rights, raising concerns or grievances and participating in governance. Classes of members include foundation member, financial member, and non-financial member.

Process:	Admissions to membership are to be considered by the Board as soon as practicable and a register of Members will be kept by the EO and stored electronically.

Membership Fees:	 The following applies to membership fees and cancellation Membership fees are non-transferable and non-refundable. Membership categories and fees are subject to change at membership renewal time. Membership fees include GST. Membership fees can be paid in full or by monthly or quarterly instalments by credit card, direct debit or bank transfer. The membership period is from 1 July to 30 June of each year. Membership period may be eligible to alter their membership to a different membership category.
